PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)
When you have a place you can call
home, that means you'll have people
you can call guests! This film will
show you how to treat them. Let's
get started, shall we?

INT. LIVING ROOM - DAY

Our HOME OWNER vacuums the floor.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)
In preparation of your guests, DO
clean and tidy your home!

CUT TO:

Our GUEST begrudgingly vacuums, while the Owner points to places on the floor.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)
Do NOT make your guest clean and
tidy your home for you.

EXT. FRONT DOOR - DAY

The Owner opens the door and lets the Guest in.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)
DO promptly invite your guest into
your home.

CUT TO:

The front door remains closed as the Guest stands in the
rain.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)

Do NOT leave your guest out in the
rain!

INT. DINING ROOM - DAY

The Owner hands the Guest a glass of juice.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)

DO serve your guest a beverage!

INT. KITCHEN - DAY

The Owner looks into the fridge, pulls out a carton of orange
juice from the back, looks at it, and shrugs.

INT. DINING ROOM - DAY

The Guest drinks from a glass of suspicious looking juice,
and does a spit take.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)

Do NOT serve your guest a beverage
that has been sitting in the back
of your refrigerator for months!

INT. LIVING ROOM - DAY

The Guest sits on a couch, shivering. The Owner hands the
Guest a coat.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)

If your guest begins to feel
chilly, DO offer them a coat!

CUT TO:

The Guest sits on a couch, shivering. The Owner hands the Guest a tiny coat. The guest struggles to put it on.

PROF. NORBERT (V.O.)
Do NOT offer your guest a coat
three sizes too small!

INT. KITCHEN - DAY

Professor Norbert is wearing rubber gloves while washing dishes. He turns to face the camera.

Well, there you have it! You are
now ready to be a hospitable host
for your guests. I hope you've
